January 19th- Virtual meeting with delegates from the Conference Report and Charter Committee. Purpose of meeting was to discuss preparation for the Conference.

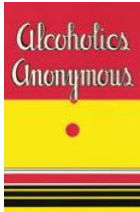
January 22nd- District 6/7 Day of Sharing – Women in AA.
