

Districts formed back up and participation in the General Service Structure began to take shape once again


Area Inventory & Ad Hoc 2022-2023

Transitional = Great time to get involved!


New Panel = Everyone is new to their positions Learn, grow & build new connections, together!



Next is January 6th! (this Saturday!)










Why attend the GSA?

- Get <u>connected</u>, get <u>informed</u>








What to expect?


