"Trusted Servant" What is that anyway?

"The strength of our whole AA service structure starts with the group and the GSR the group elects. I cannot emphasize too strongly the GSR's importance." - Bill Wilson on the Area and Group level Trusted Servant.

Asking members to serve does not put them in a different rank or class than other members. Instead, it establishes a relationship of

TRUST.

- Trusted servants are placed in a position of trust by the group conscience of the Fellowship they serve. By trust, meaning that they are placed
- with the authority to act responsibly,
 - within their best judgment

Why hold only ONE position

- Gives other fellows an opportunity to be of service as well
- It is better to leave a service role open than try to fill them all yourself.
 Lets God fill the position instead
- Folks are more inclined to volunteer for an open service commitment than to "take" one from a fellow
- Allows you to commit fully to your roles as a trusted servant
 - In the words of Ron Swanson...
 "Never half ass two things. Whole ass one thing."

<u>Quarterly(ish)</u> General Service Assemblies (4 per year)


Carrying info back to the homegroup for business meetings


