GSA exists with Areas and districts because as AA grew Bill W. Was concerned for its future, understanding he would not live forever. 36 structures around the world- our area is part of US and Canada. District helps convey group conscience for the AA groups in it. Both groups will benefit by people continuing to make the effort to bridge the gap between Intergroup and GSA. Area 50 is aware of this effort.

Don W.- spoke to the growth in AA in our area over the last 40 + years. But it has also made it uncommon for people to travel to meeting outside their area. Developing district could help with that sharing of communication, benefitting the whole.

They asked the group for a show of hands when asked if they knew of AA- 14 of 92 did. Then asked for a show of hands how many counseled clients to go to AA when out? 2 of 92. AA has made great headway by working with that community. There is the CPC/PIC committees and there are dedicated people at the World Service level to help guide that process. We are not alone. Possibilities - schools/ colleges, public, libraries, jails, spectrum, fairs, many other options Discuss.

Include the flyer as part of discussion where can it be posted? Hand out.

FYI- 3% of people that actually qualify for AA are in AA. Based on figure of 10% of population is alcoholic and general population numbers. It is a rough estimate but lots of room for carrying the message.

How we can start to turn the lights on in our own community. Discuss what may be of interest to them- committees listed below have lots of information-we don't have to recreate the wheel.

Committees are
